
MULTICONTACTS

"Multicontacts" fine art project (incorporated to author's interdisciplinary theoretical Ph.D. research at FAMU) has been creating from 2012 using by combined contact technique of layered drawing, drawing by light and engraving on the large format sensitive gelatin silver papers and negatives (up to 108 – 155 cm). In some targeted cases author has recycled fragments of these works and builds a new ones in form of photograms.

Even before the current situation, author was in the perspective of his previous projects (Shot, Line of Forces, Short Story about an Island etc.) interested in questions of contemporary technological, information and social layering of the world. Which has been transfering to individual works and projects in a subjective visual forms.

At the same time, author is an active musician, which is (though rather subconsciously) projected in structure and composition of Multicontact project (author cooperates f.e. with Czech composer of contemporary music Jakub Rataj and just a connection with sound surfaces are one of the future chapters of this project).

But what author didn't expect in any way is, that this serie, at least as far as the name is concerned, will became so symptomatic in today horizon.
